HUTCHINGS, WESTSIDE STUDENT NAMED STATE COLLEGE AND CAREER ACADEMY STUDENT OF THE YEAR

(MACON, GA) – Daylen Lomeli, a third-year student at W.S. Hutchings College and Career Academy, has been named Georgia's College and Career Academy Student of the Year.
